What we collect

- your name
- email address.

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

Security of your information

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we are in the process of putting in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect.

How we use cookies on our web site

We use cookies for Google Analytics to identify which pages are being accessed. This helps us analyse anonymous data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes.
