

## **The George Community Pub – 200 CLUB RULES**

1. The name of the draw is The George Community Pub 200 Club (“the Lottery”) regardless of the number of tickets that are in existence at any time.
2. The purpose of the Lottery is to raise funds for the sole benefit of The George Community Pub. (The George Pub). The George Pub will determine the specific projects to which funds will be allocated. All of these will reflect the aims and objectives of The George Community Pub.
3. The Lottery will be administered by George Hering – The Promoter, who is also a member of The George Community Pub committee.
4. Fifty percent of the 200 Club income will be retained for specific projects reflecting the aims and objectives of the George Community Pub, the remaining fifty percent will be used as prizes in our monthly draw. Starting in January 2024 the prize fund will be divided into 13 months to allow for a double value bumper draw in December. Prizes will be offered on a pro-rata basis until all 200 tickets have been taken up. For example, if only 50 tickets have been sold at the date of the first monthly draw, then only a quarter of the prize money will be paid.
5. The Lottery will be open to anybody aged 16 or over. A purchaser of a ticket becomes a participant in the Lottery. Participants shall be limited to four tickets until and unless The George Pub committee determines to make more tickets available to existing participants. In the case of being oversubscribed a reserve list will be created.
6. The number of tickets in the Lottery shall be limited to a maximum of 200 and each ticket shall be allocated a unique number. Participants may confirm the number of their allocated ticket/s by contacting the Promoter.
7. The subscription for each ticket is £5 per calendar month payable monthly in advance by standing order. There shall be a draw made on the last day of each calendar month using an automatic random generator or other such means as the Promoter deems appropriate. The draw must be held in the presence of at least two members of The George Community Pub Committee on such occasions and time as the Promoter shall deem appropriate. One of the present Committee members may also be the Promoter.
8. Winners will be paid by cheque or by electronic payment into the participants bank account. It is the responsibility of the participant to advise the Promoter of any change of address or account detail. A list of prize-winning numbers will be published on The George Community Pub’s website every month and within 10 days of any draw taking place.
9. The Promoter will not pay a prize to any participant other than the purchaser of a winning ticket.
10. No Lottery participant will be included in the draw if their subscription has not been received. It is the responsibility of each participant to make sure they have paid their subscription on time. The Promoter reserves the right to reallocate any number where payment has not been received.
11. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month’s written notice to the Promoter. Any decision by The George Community Pub to end the Lottery will also be by one month’s notice to all Participants.
12. Subscriptions cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
13. The Promoter will determine any dispute. An appeal may be made to The George Pub Committee Chairman whose decision shall be final.
14. The Lottery is intended to be a Small Society Lottery for members, supporters, and friends of The George Community Pub (Wickham Market) Ltd under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005.
15. The George Community Pub may amend or vary the rules of the Lottery at any time. The rules of the Lottery will be available via the George Pub’s website. Changes will be notified to Participants via the Pub’s website.
